LITERACY	Reading	Daily Language	Writing Task	Spelling
MONDAY	At least 20 minutes	Week 24, Day 1	Free write OR Outside the window, you see something you can't believe. What is it? Be as detailed as possible.	Cut out or write down your words and sort them. Check the YouTube and answer key (on website & GC) to make sure you're correct.
TUESDAY	At least 20 minutes	Week 24, Day 2	Free write OR Write a story about this picture: https://bit.ly/2znAHDR	Speed sort your words and read them all out loud.
WEDNESDAY	At least 20 minutes	Week 24, Day 3	Free write OR Do you prefer to spend time by yourself, or with others? Tell me why and under what circumstances.	Practice writing all your words, try not to look after first seeing what word to write.
THURSDAY	At least 20 minutes	Week 24, Day 4	Free write OR If you could travel back in time, where/when would you go? What would you do? Why?	Have a family member test you on your words. Make sure you're spelling them correctly and putting them under the right heading.
FRIDAY	At least 20 minutes	Week 24, Day 5	Free write OR Do you have a pet? Write about a day in the life of one of your pets. What do they do? What do they think? Try to write from their perspective ("I wagged my tail...")	Spelling test (audio for test on Google Classroom and website).

MONDAY	1815	Week 24, Day 1	Look around outside. What kinds of patterns can you see in your neighbourhood? Look at the road, the sidewalk, the sky, the trees, etc.	Algebra Word Problems 6
TUESDAY	6774	Week 24, Day 2	There are approximately 180 school days in a year. Calculate how many days you attend school if you're absent 10% of the time, 25% of the time, and 50% of the time. Can you put this in decimal and fraction form?	Division 1
WEDNESDAY	3582	Week 24, Day 3	Make a graph of how many steps it takes you to walk to different parts of your home. Pick one starting place, and count how many steps it takes you to get to the bathroom, kitchen, bedroom, living room, front door, etc.	Estimating Sums and Differences 3
