This week's work is listed below for each subject area. You can find many videos, links, and other learning opportunities on my website www.kelsilesowski.com. You'll also find expectations, suggested routines, and more on my website. Many of these assignments are posted on Google Classroom, but all of them can be submitted to me through my website under the appropriate subject submission form.

In the learning packages you picked up from the school, your child has been supplied with notebooks, daily language, daily math, spelling words and test sheets, and other useful pages. If your child prefers to use pencil and paper or doesn't have access to a device, please take a picture of their work and submit through my website. They can also be keeping track of their work with the tracker sheet I included. Guidelines for how much they should be doing in each subject is listed on the tracker sheet.

Remember to treat this list as a menu, you don't have to try everything. Some families will find this type of learning more difficult, and some may want more work for their kids. Home learning is going to look very different than what we would do at school.

Ministry guidelines suggest 7-10 hours of school work per day for intermediate students, including lots of inquiry, play, and outside time. The work I'm providing may take longer for some students, and some may go through it quickly. Please try to follow the expectations on the tracker sheet and on my website, and if your student doesn't complete assignments, they can submit partial ones as well.

Everything is due Friday, April 17 5:00pm. Feel free to submit assignments daily, or wait until the end of the week to submit. If more time is needed to complete the work, or you aren't able to complete the work, please just let me know. We all have to be flexible during this time, and your social-emotional needs come first. If you need guidance or support in how to navigate my website, submit work, or anything else, please don't hesitate to contact me and I'll do my best to help you through it.
