LITERACY	Reading	Daily Language	Writing Task	Spelling
MONDAY	At least 20 minutes	Week 23, Day 1	Free write OR Find your list of goals that you wanted to meet during the month of May. Did you meet them? If yes, what helped you reach your goals? If no, what prevented you from reaching your goals?	Cut out or write down your words and sort them. Check the YouTube and answer key (on website & GC) to make sure you're correct.
TUESDAY	At least 20 minutes	Week 23, Day 2	Free write OR Write a story about this picture: https://bit.ly/2Tt7s9E	Speed sort your words and read them all out loud.
WEDNESDAY	At least 20 minutes	Week 23, Day 3	Free write OR An adjective is a word that describes a noun (person, place, thing). Write a story using as many adjectives as you can think of. If you're having trouble thinking of adjectives, here are a few: funny, happy, sad, angry, clean, beautiful, little, thankful, handsome, jolly, kind, polite, worried, scary, proud, short, tall, tense, hungry, tasty.	Practice writing all your words, try not to look after first seeing what word to write.
THURSDAY	At least 20 minutes	Week 23, Day 4	Free write OR Create a list with the names of everyone you know. This could include friends, family or favorite characters from stories! Then organize the names alphabetically. Up for a challenge? Arrange the names by the number of letters in them.	Have a family member test you on your words. Make sure you're spelling them correctly and putting them under the right heading.
FRIDAY	At least 20 minutes	Week 23, Day 5	Free write OR Pick your favorite show to watch and write a scene of your own. Start with just two characters and one situation. To challenge yourself, add more characters or include a second situation.	Spelling test (audio for test on Google Classroom and website).

NUMERACY	Number of the Day	Daily Math	Math Task	Worksheet
MONDAY	4097	Week 23, Day 1	If you added up the ages of everyone in your family, what would the total be? Estimate first, and then add. Was your estimate close? If you want a challenge, include the ages of your grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins and even your friends.	Skip Counting 6
TUESDAY	2351	Week 23, Day 2	Write down all the whole numbers from 1 to 10. Then, add all of the numbers together. Was there a strategy you used to make it easier? Try to add all of these: $10+20+30+40+50$. Did you group the numbers in different ways to make it easier to solve? Ask a family member to try it and compare your methods!	Money Word Problems 5
WEDNESDAY	5528	Week 23, Day 3	Measure the perimeter and area of at least 3 windows in your home. Use a standard unit of measure (centimeters) and a non-standard unit of measure (hand, book, water bottle, etc). - ie. one of the windows in my house has a perimeter of 278 cm or 22 hands, and an area of 4590cm^2 (85×54) or 28 hands^2 (7×4).	Multiplying Fractions 2
THURSDAY	7283	Week 23, Day 4	Draw a picture using only these shapes: Circles, triangles, and rectangles. Try to use at least 3 of each shape.	Adding and Subtracting Time 2
FRIDAY	6465	Week 23, Day 5 & brain stretch	Pick 4 of something (movies, pizza toppings, ice cream flavours, video games, etc.). Ask everyone you can which of those 4 is their favourite and least favourite. Make a graph to show your results.	Algebra Word Problems 5
